2. HOW YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION IS COLLECTED.

We collect personal information from the following categories of sources:

3. HOW AND WHY WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION.

Under data protection laws, we can only use your personal information if we have a proper reason for doing so, for example:

- To comply with our legal and regulatory obligations
- For the performance of our contract with you or to take steps at your request before entering into a contract
- For our legitimate interests or those of a third party –or–
- Where you have given consent

A legitimate interest is when we have a business or commercial reason to use your information, so long as this is not overridden by your own rights and interests.

We process your personal information for a variety of reasons, depending on how you interact with our Services, including:

To facilitate account creation and authentication and otherwise manage user accounts. We may process your information so you can create and log in to your account, as well as keep your account in working order.

To deliver and facilitate delivery of Services to the user. We may process your information to provide you with the requested service.

To send administrative information to you. We may process your information to send you details about our Services, changes to our terms and policies, and other similar information.

To request feedback. We may process your information when necessary to request feedback and to contact you about your use of our Services.

To send you marketing and promotional communications. We may process the personal information you send to us for our marketing purposes, if this is in accordance with your marketing preferences. 
Right to Limit Use of Sensitive Personal Information

You have the right to limit the use and disclosure of your sensitive personal information to the use which is necessary to:

Right of Correction	If we maintain inaccurate personal information about you, you have the right to request us to correct that inaccurate personal information. Upon receipt of a verifiable request from you, we will use commercially reasonable efforts to correct the inaccurate personal information.
Protection Against Retaliation	You have the right to not be retaliated against by us because you exercised any of your rights under the CCPA/CPRA. This means we cannot, among other things:

- Provide a different level or quality of Services to you –or–
- Suggest that you will receive a different price or rate for Services or a different level or quality of goods or Services

 that the person making the request is the person about whom we collected information or is
 someone authorized to act on such person's behalf.
- Any personal information we collect from you to verify your identity in connection with you
 request will be used solely for the purposes of verification.

10. KEEPING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION SECURE.

We have appropriate security measures in place to prevent personal information from being accidentally lost or used or accessed in an unauthorized way.
